## Power up with solar

SOLAR energy company Rezeko aims to put a solar system on the roof of every Australian home.

The company was established after director Erik Zimmerman watched a movie on the earth's looming energy crisis in 2006 and decided to do something about it.

After researching the existing industry Mr Zimmerman established a business that sold neighbourhood solar systems.

"This meant we could buy in bulk, provide greater purchasing power and generate cost savings in installation, travel and warehousing," he said.

"I purchased a container of solar panels, used my own savings and enrolled 50 local

households to join the very first solar neighbourhood in October 2007.

"Since then, Rezeko has installed more than 200 solar power systems in the Whitehorse area and has 79 participating solar neighbourhoods located throughout Australia's east coast."
